

Four easy steps to using **hoopla**™

- ▶ Register for an account by visiting www.hoopladigital.com or using the hoopla app on your iOS or Android mobile device and click **Sign Up**. You will need to provide an email address, create a password, and have your library card and PIN number.
- ▶ Easily browse titles on your computer or device by clicking **Browse** and choosing the **Music**, **Movies**, **Audiobooks**, or **Television** tab. You can also **Search** for a specific title, author, or actor.
- ▶ To borrow a title click on the title's icon then click **Borrow**. Borrowed titles can be found under the **My Titles** tab for easy use.
- ▶ Borrowed titles will be automatically returned when your lending period is over.

What's available through

hoopla?

Movies and TV Shows can be checked out for a loan time of 3 days (72 hours).

You will borrow TV Shows by episode, not season.



Loans begin the moment you click or tap "borrow."

Music Albums are checked out for 7 days.



Instead of a single track, you can borrow an entire album of music.

Audiobooks are checked out for 21 days (3 weeks).

You borrow audiobooks and stream them in their entirety. No more tracks or discs to worry about!

Q: How can I sign up for hoopla?

A: Go to www.hoopladigital.com and click Sign Up. (You will need a valid library card.)

Q: Do I need a PIN number?

A: No.

Q: How many items can I borrow?

A: Ten (10) total items per calendar month.

Q: I'm finished with my hoopla loan. Can I return it early?

A: Yes.

Q: Who picks the lending periods?

A: hoopla's content providers.

Q: Are there any ads or any cost?

A: No. hoopla is a free library service.

Q: How often does hoopla get new content?

A: Weekly.

Q: Is what I watch or listen to private?

A: Yes.

Q: Does the mobile app include the same content as hoopla on a PC?

A: Yes.

Q: Are titles downloaded to my device or computer?

A: Most titles are available for download only on iOS (Apple) devices. Downloads are playable only in the hoopla app and are subject to the available storage on your device. Not all titles are available for download, but all titles are available for streaming on devices and computers.

Q: Do I need to be connected to the Internet to use hoopla?

A: Yes.

Q: Can I play hoopla content on more than one device at a time?

A: No, but you can pause on one device and pick up where you left off on another.

Q: Do I need special software to use hoopla?

A: For mobile devices, all you need is the app. To use hoopla on your computer, you will need to download Google WIDEVINE, available at: <https://tools.google.com/dlpage/widevine>
